Supplementary Regulations

1. The Launceston and North Cornwall Motor Club Ltd will organise a Clubman Sporting Trial on Saturday 17 June 2023 at Higher Frankaborough Farm, Broadwoodwidge, Lifton, Devon (nr 190/393916) (What 3 words-boards, footsteps, pylons) by kind permission of the Harvey family.
 2. The meeting will be governed by the General Regulations of the Motor Sports UK. (incorporating the provisions of the International Sporting Code of the FIA). These Supplementary Regulations and any written instructions that the organising Club may issue for the event.
 3. Permit numbers TBA.
 4. The event is a qualifying round of the 2023 ASWMC Sporting Trials Championship.
 5. The event is open to any registered ASWMC Sporting Trials contender & all contenders & passengers over 17 must produce a valid MS UK RS clubman licence & Club Member card. Non contenders must be members of the organising club (Membership £10.00) or members of BTRDA, 750MC, Camel Vale Motor Club who must hold a MS UK RS Clubman Licence and passengers over 17 must also hold a MS UK RS Clubman licence and a motor club membership card (Club passenger membership £1).
 6. The programme will be:-
 - Entry Paper by closing date
 - Sign on by 11.45 on the day
 - Scrutineering from 11.00
 - First car starts at 12.00
 7. Public roads will not be used to link sections. There will be at least 6 sections on private land & at least 3 rounds (weather permitting). The entry may be split into groups starting on different hills.
 8. The event will consist of four classes as follows:-
 - 1 Red - IND
 - 2 Red LIVE
 - 3 Blue IND
 - 4 Blue LIVE
 - 5 Green Class Novice drivers as per the BTRDA listings and other drivers.
 - 6 Post Historic.
 9. All vehicles must comply with Motor Sport UK Technical Regulations. All vehicles must have effective silencing; any vehicle considered by the scrutineer to be too noisy will not be allowed to start. Tyres must comply with 2023 Motor Sport UK year book - 12.9.3. All cars in the post historic class can use tyres in accordance with T14.81 & T14.82.
 10. Awards will be presented as follows:
 1. The Spry Trophy to the Best Performance overall.
 2. Class win to winner of the other classes. (Subject to at least 4 entrants).
- Other awards may be presented at organiser's discretion.
11. The entry opens on publication of regs and closes finally on 13th June 2023. The entry fee is £40.00. All entries must be made on the official entry form and accompanied by the appropriate fee. There will be no entries on the day.

13. The maximum entry for the meeting is 20. The minimum is 8. The minimum for each class is 4. Should any minimum figure not be reached the organisers have the right to cancel the meeting or amalgamate the classes. Entry fees may be refunded if notified by 13th June 2023.

15. Provisional results will be published asap after the end of the event.

16. Any protest must be lodged in accordance with 06.2.6.

17. Starting numbers will be decided by ballot and provided by the organisers.

18. The finish will be at the venue. Toilet on site. No refreshments available on site.

Directions from A30 west or east take exit sign(2.5 miles NE of Lifton) for Broadwoodwidge, Stowford & Bratton Clovelly, travel north(do NOT follow Sat Nav through Broadwood village) for 1.5 miles over Roadford Dam, continue for approx 3 miles to T junction (Broadwood CP school & phone box on your left)Turn LEFT & then take second LEFT at Dubbs Cross (small hamlet plus phone box) signposted Lifton & Cross Green. Drive 1 mile & first lane on the LEFT (sign Frankaborough Farm) in a couple of hundred yards .

The route will be arrowed from A30

20. Please note, strictly no unauthorised vehicles or motorcycles to be taken beyond the paddock.
