- Launceston and North Cornwall Motor Club Ltd. will promote a Clubman permit Sporting Car Trial for the David Ayers Trophy at Trevilla Farm, Marshgate, Camelford, Cornwall, PL32 9YN on Sunday 8th September 2024. Map Ref. 190 145911.What3Words Lane Entrance -STILTED.CURTAINS.DIGNITY Field - EMINENT.SLICK.APPOINTS
- 2. The Meeting will be governed by the General Competitions Rules, Standing Supplementary Regulations of Motor Sport UK. Incorporating the provisions of the international Sporting code of the FIA, these SRs and any written instructions of which the promoting Club may issue for the event.
- 3. A Motor Sport UK permit applied for.
- 4. The event is open to all full elected members of the organizing Club (membership £10.00) & members of Northern Phoenix Trials Car Club and any contenders in the BTRDA and ASWMC Sporting Trial Championships and all members of Clubs that are running rounds in the BTRDA Sporting Trials Championship.
- 5. All drivers & passengers over 17 must hold a MotorSport UK RS Clubman licence & appropriate motor club membership card (Club passenger membership £2.50)
- 6. THE EVENT is a qualifying round of the 2024 Motor Sport UK ,2024 ASWMC Sporting Trial and 2024 BTRDA Sporting Trial Championships.
- 7. SCRUTINEERING will start at 9.00 am. First test will start at 10.30 am. Any Competitor not signed on by 10.00 am may be excluded.
- 8. THE START will be at Trevilla Farm. Public roads will not be used to link sections and there will be 8 sections there will be 3 rounds (weather permitting). The entry will be split into groups starting at different sections.
- 9. All vehicles must comply with Motor Sport UK Technical Regulations. All vehicles must have efficient silencing. Any vehicle deemed too noisy by scrutineer will be excluded.
- 10. Permitted tyres for all Championship contenders are- Yokohama GT Classic Y350 H, NangkangCX668, T-Trac 2, Maxxis MA-510N . Class 6 vehicles can use any tyres previously listed in the Motor Sport UK yearbooks including Toyo 330 to compete for class award only & may not be included in overall classification. All cars in the post historic class can use tyres in accordance with T14.8.1 & T14.8.2.
- 11. The Event will consist of six classes as follows: :
 - (1) RED Driver Independent Suspension as per BTRDA listings
 - (2) RED Driver Live Axle as per the BTRDA listings
 - (3) BLUE Driver Independent Suspension as per the BTRDA listings
 - (4) BLUE Driver Live Axle as per the BTRDA listings
 - (5) GREEN Class Novice drivers as per the BTRDA listings
 - (6) CLUBMAN Any non BTRDA classified driver, or not sealed to 2021 BTRDA differential rules, or running any previously listed MSUK tyre.
 - (7) POST HISTORIC
- 12. THE AWARDS WILL BE PRESENTED AS FOLLOWS:-

DAVID AYERS TROPHY and REPLICA – Best Overall Performance
THE FRANK AYERS TROPHY and Replica – Best Performance in Class 6
CLASS AWARD – for best performance in each class(subject to at least 4 entrants)
OTHER AWARDS will be presented at organizers' discretion.

Points from this event will count toward Cann Medland Trophy & members Challenge Bowl. L&NCMC members only.

- 13. THE ENTRY LIST opens on receipt of Regs. and closes finally on Tuesday 3 September 2024. THE ENTRY FEE is £45.00). All entries must be made on an official entry form and accompanied by the appropriate fee.
